



## **Lebanon Warrior Athletic Guidance**

Revised September 1, 2021

### **Spectator Expectations**

#### **Student Spectators:**

Student spectators will be required to wear masks while indoors at Lebanon City School facilities when within 6-feet of another person.

**Example:** A mask is required to attend a volleyball game if you are sitting within 6-feet of another student. This supports the effort to eliminate “classroom settings”, restrict the spread, and limit quarantines during the school closure.

#### **General Spectator Guidance:**

We highly recommend the use of facial coverings and spacing 6-feet from non-household members while in the stands, both indoors and outdoors.

#### **Cross Country Meet:**

The Running Warrior Cross Country Meet will go on as planned at LHS on Saturday, September 4th. Like last year, the following arrangements have been implemented for the safety of the student-athletes:

- Assigned locations for participating school “camp sites” that are spaced appropriately
- Adjusted race schedule to stagger crowd arrivals/departures
- Cancellation of award ceremonies to avoid congregating
- Reconfigured starting area to space runners
- Reconfigured finish to avoid congestion
- Bottled water provided at the finish line instead of cups
- Spectator maps will be issued upon arrival showing widespread options for viewing
- No locker rooms available
- No concessions (Except bottled water)



### **Safety Protocols & Reminders:**

#### **Self-Symptom Checks:**

All student-athletes, coaches, official team personnel should continue to complete a Covid-19 Self-Symptom check before arriving on campus at Lebanon or any of our athletic venues. Anyone who is feeling ill or has any signs of COVID, should not enter any athletic facility or school property.

#### **Hydration:**

Each student-athlete should provide their own water bottle with their name clearly marked on it. Lebanon will not provide water for teams due to safety reasons. We will have one designated person (Site Supervisor and/or Athletic Trainer) that will be responsible for filling water supply if needed. Ice will not be available as well unless it's a medical emergency. Water fountains should not be used.

#### **Benches:**

We will do our best to space benches and social distance all members of each team. It's recommended that student-athletes, coaches, and staff wear masks when not competing. There will be hand sanitizer accessible to all team personnel but individuals are encouraged to bring their own. We'll limit sideline personnel to participants, coaches and game day staff.

#### **Locker Rooms:**

For safety reasons, teams will have limited access to locker rooms. Bathrooms will be made available for visiting teams along with a secure place to store their belongings.

#### **Transportation:**

Masks are required on buses along with assigned seating for potential contact tracing purposes. Additionally, shared trips between teams are limited and extra buses are taken when possible to allow optimal spacing between students.

#### **Meeting Space / Film Sessions:**

All film and/or team meetings should take place in classroom space where safe distancing can be achieved.

#### **Athletic Trainers:**

There will continue to be a Premier Health certified Athletic Trainer on site or in the vicinity for all athletic events on our main campus. Our on-site training room will be a 1:1 ratio during this time.
