Your child will be assigned to either the morning or afternoon class. This year's class times are:

Morning: 9:15 am - 12:00 pm (Monday through Thursday)

Afternoon: 1:15 pm - 4:00 pm (Monday through Thursday)



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All children should bring:

- One large backpack, large enough to hold a pocket folder (no wheels, please)
- One change of clothes in a ziplock baggie to be kept inside their backpack, labeled with your child's name on bag
- 1 box of Crayola markers
- A family picture to be displayed at school

Morning class:

- 1 jar of disinfectant wipes
- 1 box of tissues.
- 3 pack of Elmer's giant glue sticks

Afternoon class:

- 1 box of Crayola crayons
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 pack of Expo dry erase markers, chisel tip, assorted colors

Optional donations:

- Right Handed and Left Handed Kids Blunt Tip Scissors
- Fine tip Sharpies

If your child is not yet potty trained:

- A supply of diapers/pull-ups to keep here at school. If you choose to send pull-ups, we do request that you send the ones with the resealable sides. As we get low we will send home a note requesting more.
- A pack of wipes with your child's name on them.
