

Lebanon City Schools- Bowman Primary School Grade 1 Spanish Immersion Program for 2024-2025

KEY DETAILS FROM THE PRESENTATION

- When it comes to language there's no such thing as starting too early.
- Language is acquired through content instruction
- 50/50 model (Delaware Model)
- First grade students will have two teachers next year and will switch classes each day
- Math & science will be taught in **Spanish** by a teacher proficient in Spanish
- English language arts and social studies will be taught in **English** by a teacher proficient in English
- Immersion class sizes will be 28 students
- We will have two first grade immersion classrooms for 2023-2024 school year
- Students will proceed to 2nd grade as an immersion cohort
- Successful immersion students have these attributes
 - Desire to participate
 - OK with increased transitions
 - Knows letters and sounds in English
 - Solid attendance
 - Doesn't resist work at home
 - Able to persevere
 - o Immersion isn't the last straw...

- Successful immersion families have these attributes
 - Patience
 - OK with academic dips
 - Takes a long view of growth and achievement
 - Doesn't worry about one test score
 - Can support and encourage at home

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

- The Department of Curriculum and Instruction 160 Miller Road is conducting enrollment processes for this program.
- For your child to be considered, you must indicate interest by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 12, 2024.
- There are two ways to indicate interest:
